At 7:00 p.m., Mr. Lamb called the meeting to order followed by Mrs. Byram offering a word of prayer. Mrs. Claflin made a motion to approve the Agenda. Mr. Leininger seconded the motion and the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Irwin read the certified election results to the board. Mr. Lamb and Mr. Sprenkle (via Facetime) took the Oath of Office. Mr. Irwin asked for nominations for board president. Mrs. Claflin nominated Mr. Lamb. Mr. Lamb was elected President of the Board with 4 in favor and Mr. Lamb abstained. Mr. Lamb nominated Mrs. Byram for vice president, she was elected with 4 in favor and she abstained. Mr. Lamb nominated Ms. Coquillette for board secretary, she was elected with 5 in favor and none opposed. Mrs. Claflin nominated Mr. Sprenkle for treasurer, he was elected with 5 in favor and none opposed. There was discussion on setting the day and time for the monthly meetings of the board. The board decided to continue meeting on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month for now, and will readdress the issue in August.

In Community Forum, Mr. Irwin informed the board that he is still in discussion with the city about selling the old high school building to them. He also informed the board there will be a retirement party for Mrs. Compton on May 20<sup>th</sup> at 1 p.m. for Mrs. Compton.

Mrs. Moran made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda. Mr. Lamb seconded the motion and the motion carried 5 in favor and none opposed.

After some discussion, Mrs. Claflin made a motion to pay the bills. Mrs. Byram seconded the motion and the motion carried 5-0.

Mr. Irwin reviewed the balance and budget for the board. Some discussion followed.

Mr. Irwin informed the board the kindergarten classroom is getting fixed by Dennis Masters. He will be finishing it this Saturday if the window gets in. Mr. Irwin told the board that the man hired to remove the trees is waiting for dry weather to get it done. Two toilets in the high school had to have flush valves installed this month and the walk-in freezer has been repaired.

Under Old Business, the Board Scholarship was discussed. The committee made a motion to give two students a scholarship. Mr. Lamb seconded the motion and the motion carried 5-0. Mr. Irwin updated the board on the ongoing actions taken by the staff in connection with COVID. Mr. Irwin suggested tabling the digital sign issue until we have a better idea of how the budget will look for the next school year. After some discussion, the board agreed.

Under New Business, the board discussed the need to adjust the school calendar to make up the snow day from March 11<sup>th</sup> to change the last day of school to May 20<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Lamb so-moved, Mrs. Byram seconded the motion and the motion carried 5-0. Mrs. Compton gave the board members a list of the end of the year activities coming up. Mr. Irwin discussed with the board the new 5-year contract OPAA is offering. After some discussion, Mrs. Byram made a motion to approve the contract. Mrs. Claflin

seconded the motion and the motion carried 5-0. At this time Mr. Irwin discussed baseball/softball with the board. Due to issues having enough students to form teams, he is looking into the possibility of doing a coop with Bronaugh. Discussion followed and the board will be informed when more information is available.

Mr. Irwin reviewed the A.D. Report for the board. (see attached)


Mrs. Compton gave her Principal's Report to the board. (see attached)

## SPRING SPORTS UPDATE

HS BASEBALL: Baseball has had 5 games so far this season. We are 0-5. We are still learning how to play baseball with so many kids being new to the game. Hoping to get outside to practice on the baseball field for the first time this year. We play @ Hume next Tuesday at 4:00 and @ NEVC on Thursday @ 4:30. Thanks for the continued support! HS SOFTBALL: Softball has had 2 games so far this season. The girls have learned a lot about the game and continue to improve. Our first game was on 3/28/22 against NEVC with a score of 20-0. We had to cancel another home game on 4/6/22 due to field conditions, but we were able to pick up a game against Liberal where we fell 18-2. We will have two away games in the next few days and then we will be gearing up for districts on May 6th. Go Lady Panthers!

HS TRACK/FIELD: The High School Team has competed at seven meets this season so far with three more left to go before Districts. On Friday April 8th we had five athletes who met the qualifying times to compete at Pittsburg State University's Gorilla Relays. Kim Colbert competed in the 100m dash, 100mh, 300mh, and 4x100 relay, Maddy Garren competed in the 400m and 4x100 relay, Mariam Lamb competed in the 100m dash and 4x100 relay, Donna Byram competed in the 4x100 relay, and Dalton Maize competed in the 100m dash and 2000m steeplechase. These five competed with athletes from Missouri, Kansas, Oklahoma, and Arkansas.

This season we have had seven new school records set, Kim 100m dash 13.09, 100mh 17.24, and 300mh 49.?, Maddy 200m 29.48, and 800m 2:52.65, Girls 4x100 relay 55.12 and Girls 4x200 relay 1:57.59. We also have girls who are ranked in the top ten in the State for class 1 in multiple events.

The boys are continuing to improve with every meet and their 4x100 and 4x200 relay teams are ranked in the top four in our District. Overall this season has been very successful and I'm excited to see where we stand at the end.

MS TRACK/FIELD: The JH Team has competed in three meets so far this year and will compete at Nevada Middle School Invitational tomorrow. With each meet the JH team continues to improve with multiple athletes setting new personal records and starting to place in the top 8 in their events. Overall I am very proud of how these young athletes have continued to develop and grow and I'm thankful for the opportunity to be able to coach them.
