Approval of Agenda: A motion was made by Mrs. Byram to approve the Agenda. Mr. Sprenkle seconded the motion and the motion carried 6-0.

Consent Agenda:

Mr. Lamb made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda. Mrs. Claflin seconded the motion and the motion carried 6-0.

Financial Report:

Bills: Mrs. Byram made a motion to approve the bills. Mrs. Blurton seconded the motion and the motion carried 6-0.

Balance: Mr. Irwin reviewed the balance for the board.

We should know if we are receiving the Safety Grant by the end of the month. The new banners for the mission statement were discussed.

Old Business: CSIP: Mr. Post updated the board on the progress of the CSIP and informed them he needs to update the CSIP to include reading success plans.

New Business:

Enrollment-Mr. Irwin informed the board we currently have 206 students enrolled PK-12.
